

## St Mary's Medical Student Community Health Champion Scholarship Terms and Conditions

1. This scholarship award is valid for applicants starting in 2026/27 only and cannot be deferred.
2. Undergraduate scholarships are valid for all years of study, except for placement years with reduced tuition fees and students repeating a year.
3. The scholarship cannot be exchanged for cash. The value of the scholarship will be deducted from your tuition fees.
4. Only applicants who have passed their MMI and received a Conditional or Unconditional offer are eligible.
5. The St Mary's MBBS International Scholarship is only available to applicants who have been assessed as overseas for fee purposes. Applicants who are later assessed as Home or EU for fee purposes will not be eligible for this award.
6. Applicants who require a Student Visa to study in the UK must pay the tuition fee deposit by the date specified on their official scholarship offer letter. If this condition is not met the award may be revoked.
7. In order to continue receiving their scholarships, students must remain in good academic standing with the University. Scholarship discounts will not be applied where students are repeating a year of study. Students may regain eligibility once they have met all requirements to progress to the next year of study and meet all UKVI attendance and engagement requirements. Note that scholarships are awarded prior to enrolment.
8. St Mary's University awards this scholarship on the basis that all information and documentation provided to Admissions is factual and correct. The award will be revoked if the application contains fraudulent information.
9. In accordance with St Mary's regulations, this scholarship may not be held in conjunction with any other St Mary's University scholarship or alumni discount as only one scholarship can be applied per student record. Applicants who are assessed as eligible for more than one scholarship should reject one of their awards. Alternatively, applicant records will be automatically adjusted at enrolment stage.
10. Students receiving external awards or sponsorship which cover St Mary's tuition fees in full are not eligible for the St Mary's MBBS International Scholarship, as it is expected that their fee requirements will be met by the external scholarship.
11. By accepting the International Scholarship, applicants agree to represent St Mary's University as an ambassador throughout their degree programme. Ambassadorial activities may include providing testimonials or content for social media and other marketing activities, and participating at University Open Days or international promotional events (in-person or virtually).
